Dr. William Jay Crone joined the Virginia Tech faculty in 1994 and serves as Professor of Low Brass. He has appeared as a soloist and chamber musician in Europe, Asia, South America and at the American Trombone Workshop and Southeast Regional Horn and Tuba/Euphonium Workshops. He has also been a collaborative pianist in recitals throughout the United States, including performances with former members of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra and Boston Symphony Orchestra, and current members of the Philadelphia Orchestra and Florida Orchestra. Dr. Crone holds degrees from the University of Southern California, Yale University, and California State University at Fresno.
