- Relatives of the Scholarship Selection Committee are not eligible

- Interest in continuing to play in the future

- 250 Word Essay describing passion for music
- One recommendation from a teacher, band director, guidance counselor, or advisor

Timing/Selection Process

- Application Deadline: February 5, 2021 (postmark deadline)
- Applications shared with Scholarship Committee
- Scholarship Committee meets to select recipient (recipient selected by March 5)
- Scholarship recipient contacted
- Recipient awarded scholarship at Spring Concert if possible

Amount

One \$500 scholarship

Award Distribution

• Funds will be paid by the Blacksburg Community Band to the music teacher of the recipient's choice or to a school for lessons or tuition. If used for instrument repair or purchase, the award funds will be paid by the Blacksburg Community Band for reimbursement of expense incurred within one year of receiving the scholarship.
