Flute player Vicki Scarratt shares the following about Mary's career:

Mary began playing at the age of 9 in Dover, Delaware. She took lessons with another young student at the cost of 50¢ a lesson but quickly surpassed the other student. She got her union card at the age of 12.

After high school, Mary went to nursing school but still continued to play the flute. She married Jack Walters, and they raised four boys. When Jack and Mary moved to Las Vegas in 1977, she gave up nursing and focused on teaching flute and playing in many groups in the Las Vegas area. Her students consistently placed in the top at district and state auditions, and many continued on to major in music in college.

Jack and Mary moved to Blacksburg in 1999, and the rest is history! We all should be so fortunate to play at her level at the age of 89. She has had a remarkable career, and I am so fortunate to have been her friend for the last 19 years.
